For more than 70 years, the Community Scholarship Fund of Pleasantville has provided financial awards to graduating high school seniors who plan to continue their education at institutions of higher learning or professional training/apprenticeship. With education costs continuing to rise, there is an ever-increasing need for help with these expenses.

The Community Scholarship Fund is now accepting scholarship applications from the high school class of 2024. You are eligible to apply for a Community Scholarship award if you:

- Are graduating from high school in 2024.
- Either attend Pleasantville High School or reside within the Pleasantville Union Free School District;
 and.
- Will be attending college or professional training school in the fall of 2024.

Application Process

To apply for a Community Scholarship award and for your application to be considered by the Selection Committee, you must:

- Strictly follow and adhere to all of the instructions on the application;
- Meet all deadlines:
- Deliver your completed application to the PHS Guidance Office by 3:00 p.m., Monday, April 15, 2024;

The application and the instructions can be obtained online from the website www.pleasantvilleschools.com: click Pleasantville High School and look under the menu item, "Counseling", "Naviance" & then "Scholarships".

The Community Scholarship Fund's Selection Committee considers the following factors when evaluating an applicant's application including, but not limited to the applicant's academic performance, community service, financial need and extra-curricular activities. To assess your financial need, applicants are asked to prepare a personal statement explaining their state of financial need. All statements and financial information will be kept strictly confidential.

The required information is obtained from the application and the applicant's essays, personal statement of financial need(optional) and the personal interview. Following the application submission deadline, applicants will be notified to schedule their interview in late April/early May.

Should you choose to apply for an award, please note the following:

- Instructions must be followed exactly;
- Deadlines must be adhered to in order for your application to be considered;
- If any part of the application is omitted, or if a deadline is not met, the applicant will not be eligible for an interview or scholarship;
- Submitting an application does not guarantee an award of a scholarship; and
- There are no exceptions.

- ✓ Submit a 250-word essay: What touched you most about helping someone or group in the Pleasantville community?
